Purpose: a single-page map with links to each governing source and its basis. · **Covers Desk Review item:** #10 Firearms/Weapons Policy. · **Updated:** June 16, 2026

A **complete, previously-submitted firearms/weapons policy** governs storage (locked, separate locked ammunition), licensing, add/remove notification, and transport; foster homes are verified against it during the home-safety inspection. The policy currently lives in the legacy 2012 P&P manual and is **not yet migrated to a T3C doc**.

HOME SAFETY

Storage, licensing & notification

Locked storage with separately locked ammunition; unbreakable storage material (cable/chain through trigger guards for glass-front cabinets); gun licenses + firearm-training certificates on file; notify RH 24 hours before adding and within 15 days after removing; transport rules (unloaded, inaccessible, legal possession).
